## BIBLIOGRAPHY OF F. W. EDWARDS

[1888-1940]

THE LATE FREDERICK WALLACE EDWARDS was born at Fletton, Peterborough, on 28th November, 1888. He was appointed to the staff of the British Museum (Natural History) in 1910 and was a Deputy Keeper at his death on the 15th November 1940.

The bibliography contains 408 titles, the majority of which deal with Nematoceros Diptera, his work on the CULICIDAE being outstanding. He was also keenly interested in the Dipterous fauna of the British Isles. He had no private collection.

Obituary notices appeared in 1940, *Nature* 146 : 739 (by N. D. Riley), in 1941, *Entomologist* 74 : 22-24 (by J. Smart), and in *Obit. Notices of F.R.S.* 1941 : 1-11 (by A. D. Imms), the last two with portraits.

## NOTES.

1. In his papers on South American MYCETOPHILIDAE Dr. Edwards frequently mentioned the number of species by which a genus, or other group under discussion, is represented in the collections he made in South America. The report on this collection should have appeared as Part III of the *Dipt. Pat. S. Chile* series. At the time of his death Dr. Edwards had carried out a great deal of work on this material but there was no manuscript in a form suitable for publication. It is to be hoped that some one will, at a later date, be able to complete the work thus started.

2. Dr. Edwards was a member of the Diptera Sub-Committee of the Committee on Generic Nomenclature of the Royal Entomological Society of London, and before his death had completed an extensive manuscript on the Generic Names of the British Nematocera. It is to be hoped that this will eventually appear in *The Generic Names of British Insects* published by the Royal Entomological Society or elsewhere..

3. In the posthumous paper "Notes on British Fungus-Gnats (Dipt. MYCETOPHILIDAE)" Dr. Edwards stated that with regard to the SCIARINAE he was "preparing a more detailed revision for publication elsewhere." As in the case of the South American material mentioned above, no manuscript in a form suitable for publication exists.
